The Rustic 'Heel' of Italy's Boot

When we ask our Italian guides where they'd most like to take our friends who think they know Italy, we get one response: Puglia. And then they use their hands to paint a vista of gnarled olive trees silhouetted against a lapis lazuli sea. To express the amazing sunlight. To sketch the saw-toothed skyline of a village comprised entirely of "trulli"—the conical stone roofs unique to the region. You should see them describe the food you'll find—pasta from locally grown wheat, sea-fresh fish, peppery olive oil. Italians love the heel of their boot and it's easy to see why. Especially since it's also where you're as likely to find a Baroque city as a family of shepherds tending 500 sheep. Best of all, Puglia passes the most important Classic Journeys test—it offers fine leisurely walking, elegant accommodations, and a glimpse into a region and culture that's not quite like any you've encountered before.



DAY 1 »

Lecce & Otranto

- Walk coastal paths near Otranto, then linger over lunch at a masseria
- With your expert local guide stroll Lecce's Baroque old town

Your Puglia journey begins in Lecce, where you meet your expert local Classic Journeys guide and fellow travelers before setting out toward the Adriatic coast and the walled town of Otranto. As you leave the city behind, the landscape shifts to rocky shoreline, wind-sculpted scrub, and the brilliant blue of the sea stretching to the horizon. Together with your guide, you follow a coastal footpath that traces Italy's easternmost point, passing WWII bunkers, craggy watchtowers, and quiet stretches of countryside where sheep and goats graze in the wild Mediterranean vegetation. The walk feels wonderfully cinematic—your route curls from Porto Grande around Punta Faci, with the Torre del Serpe lighthouse keeping watch and stories of the 1480 Ottoman invasion adding drama to the views.

By midday, settle in at a countryside masseria—an historic fortified farmhouse now lovingly restored—perched above the sea and surrounded by rugged, sun-warmed scenery that makes a long lunch feel perfectly natural. Between courses, you can gaze back toward the cliffs and towers like those you've just walked, connecting the flavors on your plate with the landscapes beyond the terrace. Here, your hosts welcome you for an Only with Classic Journeys experience: a relaxed, multi-course meal that pairs regional recipes with thoughtfully chosen wines.

In the afternoon, return to Lecce and discover why it's often called the "Florence of the South." Stroll through the historic center where Baroque palaces and ornately carved churches glow in the soft stone the city is famous for. As you walk, you'll see the remarkably intact Roman amphitheater and the lively piazzas that anchor local life today. Along the way, your guide shares favorite spots for gelato, aperitivi, and dinner, so you can ease into the rhythms of Puglia at your own pace in the evening.

DAY 2 »

Porto Selvaggio & Matera

- Hike Porto Selvaggio's coastal trails past cliffs, coves, and watchtowers
- Arrive in Matera and explore its historic center at eye level

This morning, head to Porto Selvaggio Nature Reserve on the Ionian Sea for a coastal walk through fragrant Mediterranean vegetation, past watchtowers and hidden coves that hint at ancient civilizations. The footpaths offer far-reaching sea views and a wonderfully immersive start to the day in nature, with chances to spot seabirds and raptors riding the thermals above cliffs riddled with Paleolithic caves like Grotta del Cavallo and medieval lookout towers once used to scan the horizon for pirate raids.

Continue to the town of Nardò for lunch, where local cafés and trattorias cluster around handsome piazzas. In the afternoon, journey inland toward Matera, watching the scenery shift from coastal plains to stony hills. On arrival, join your tour leader for an eye-level orientation walk through the historic center and Sassi, highlighting favorite spots for the best gelato, spritz, and shopping. As evening settles, savor a gourmet dinner that pairs Matera's creative cuisine with regional wines, celebrating this new chapter of the journey.

DAY 3 »

Matera Canyon, Sassi & Altamura

- Walk Matera's canyon and Sassi for sweeping cave city views
- Join Maria in Altamura for homemade orecchiette and farm specialties

The morning is dedicated to discovering Matera and its surroundings on foot at eye level. Set out on a canyon walk down into the Gravina that leads to a settlement carved into the rock, where traces of past civilizations appear in cliffs, caves, and pathways shaped by centuries of human presence. This curated walking route, "only with Classic Journeys," offers an intimate look at the landscape that cradles Matera.

Return to the Sassi, where thousands of houses and some churches have been excavated in the soft tufa sandstone—people have lived in these caves since prehistoric times. Learn how some homes have been restored as little museums preserving tools, furniture, and kitchens from over 200 years ago. With your tour leader, wind through lanes, staircases, and terraces that reveal Matera's cave dwellings from ever-changing vantage points. This flowing exploration finishes back at your hotel with ample time to enjoy lunch at a quaint trattoria, explore boutiques and artisans' workshops, or unwind with a spa session.

Later in the late afternoon, travel into the countryside around Altamura to the farm of our friend Maria, passing homes draped with drying tomato vines and communal ovens where locals still bake the celebrated Pane di Altamura. Known as the only bread in Italy with a Denominazione d'Origine Protetta (DOP), it has inspired praise for thousands of years—even the Roman poet Horace called it the “best bread in the world.” Here in the wheat fields around Altamura—often called the breadbasket of Italy—you experience how Puglia’s famed durum wheat becomes everything from crusty country loaves to hand-shaped orecchiette, just the kind of pasta pilgrimage food writers rave about.

On arrival, Maria and her family welcome you into their daily rhythm: tending a flock of hundreds of sheep, making fresh and aged cheeses, and raising pigs that supply the farm’s specialties. After exploring the farm, enjoy an Only with Classic Journeys experience in their large country kitchen, sipping homemade wine as you join your hosts to prepare dinner. The hands-on, informal cooking session might feature free-range lamb, orecchiette pasta—a typical Puglian dish made by hand with simple durum wheat semolina and water—festively stuffed peppers, and a cheesecake that stands apart for its use of ricotta cheese instead of cream cheese, lending it a lighter, delicate texture and a slightly tangy flavor unique to Puglia.

DAY 4 »

Parco delle Murgia & Val d’Itria Olive Country

- Cross Parco delle Murgia on foot, admiring Matera’s best viewpoints
- Dine at a family masseria, tasting cucina povera and estate olive oil

As you bid farewell to Matera we’ve saved a special treat for you—the best view of Matera so that its magical setting lingers a little longer in your memory. On foot, trace paths across the plateau of Parco delle Murgia as the stone city slowly recedes behind you. Ancient, uninhabited cave dwellings stand guard over the canyon, and each rise in the trail reveals new views back toward Matera’s honey-colored facades. This farewell walk offers a final, sweeping sense of the UNESCO World Heritage site as one complete tapestry woven into the landscape.

Nearby is the Val d’Itria, where rolling hills, vineyards, red soil, white dry stone walls, olive groves, and trulli signal the start of your olive-oil themed chapter. Midday, our friends (brother and sister) Filippo and Chiara welcome you to their masseria for an alfresco lunch in courtyards and gardens that feel like a natural extension of the surrounding countryside, immersed in olive trees near Ostuni and Cisternino. Here, farm-to-table is not a slogan but a lived tradition: the menu highlights estate-grown produce and homemade pasta crafted with ingredients picked from the organic garden. Lunch becomes a delicious lesson in Puglia’s cucina povera—humble recipes elevated by estate olive oil, sun-ripened vegetables, and durum-wheat pasta that show why this corner of Italy now draws travelers who plan their journeys around what’s on the plate.

Later in the afternoon, travel a short distance to the Lama d’Antico area for a gentle countryside walk among olive trees, dry stone walls, and seasonal vegetable plots, passing traces of prehistoric cave dwellings tucked into the landscape. By evening, arrive at your coastal masseria, with time to relax and choose your own dinner plans.

DAY 5 »

Alberobello & Savelletri

- Approach Alberobello on foot through vineyards and trulli-dotted countryside
- Visit an oliveoil producer and sample their distinctive regional oils

This morning’s walk follows a footpath toward Alberobello, threading through oak woods, vineyards, and countryside punctuated by trulli. Along the route, notice the land’s subtle changes—the shapes of stone walls, the neat vineyards, and the first impressions of the conical rooftops rising ahead. The path winds through quiet groves, past small farms and ancient dry stone walls, offering peaceful immersion in Puglia’s countryside before entering the town.

On arrival, explore Alberobello with your tour leader. As they say, necessity is the mother of invention. And so it is in Alberobello, an incredibly picturesque village where the houses have special roofs. These trulli were built with thousands of pieces of limestone placed together one by one in a conical shape, without using concrete. As you walk the cobblestone streets, your guide shares stories and anecdotes of how in the 15th century the Kingdom of Naples imposed tributes on each new urban settlement. This led to an ingenious idea by the locals: to build their homes in such a way that they could be demolished with ease whenever the king's delegate was about to collect taxes. The look of the village is unique and fantastic, as if from a fairy tale book. Take in the views as you walk through the village with the opportunity to explore on your own the charming little shops built right inside these unique stone huts.

In the afternoon, leave town on foot and meander through some of Puglia's most ancient olive groves toward a family-run olive-oil producer. The route passes twisted trunks of every shape and size—many hundreds of years old—and opens into views of orchards that have sustained communities for generations. By now, between hand-rolled orecchiette, Altamura's famous bread, and these peppery, golden oils, it is easy to understand why Puglia has become a byword among food lovers for pasta, bread, and olive oil at their purest. At the estate, sample their oils while learning about harvesting, pressing, and how to distinguish different styles.

DAY 6 »

Savelletri
