Wild Nature Meets Tropical Luxury

You expect paradise to be beautiful. But who knew it was so much fun? Costa Rica blends adventure and nature like nowhere else. A quarter of the country is a protected paradise for everything from anteaters to orchids. The best part is how easy and exciting it is. You don't just look at the cloud forest canopy, you stroll through it on suspended bridges or glide through on a zipline. You can spot whales, explore the Osa Peninsula – named by National Geographic as "the most biologically intense place on Earth", or participate in a baby sea turtle release. You'll explore with expert naturalists, meet the native ticos, and learn about local life, including visiting a village school. Your trip features nights at the foot of Arenal Volcano and on the pristine Osa Peninsula, and all activities are included. Because Costa Rica is temperate and close to the U.S., you can join us in almost any season—and it's a great spur-of-the-moment getaway.

DAY 1 »

San José / Arenal

Your Costa Rican adventure begins in San José with a sensory awakening. Sip an exquisite cup of coffee and allow the rich aroma to hint at the volcanic soil that nourishes these world-renowned beans. Your first walk of the trip takes you through lush coffee plantations, where you'll meander between rows of coffee shrubs, their glossy leaves rustling in the gentle breeze. The walk follows gentle slopes that offer panoramic views of the Central Valley and leads to a visit with the coffee maker who shows you every step from the raw coffee "cherries" right through drying, roasting and, of course, tasting their brew. It's a great chance to learn about this distinctive (and delicious) agricultural tradition.

After, head into the tropical forest with your naturalist guide for a colorful nature walk. Marvel as five waterfalls leapfrog down a scenic tropical canyon. And make your way up the path with viewing platforms so close to the action you can feel the spray on your skin and see rainbows dancing in the mist. At a nearby butterfly observatory, a loop trail takes you through a kaleidoscope of fluttering wings. The air hums with the buzz of hummingbirds, their iridescent feathers flashing as they dart from flower to flower. Hold out your hand and feel the gentle tickle of a butterfly's delicate feet or the whisper-soft breeze from a hummingbird's wings.

Later in the day, arrive at your boutique hotel at the foot of Arenal Volcano. A near-perfect cone, the volcano has been dormant for many years now. Enjoy the scenic setting and one of the happiest side effects of volcanic activity: the hot springs that bubble to the surface all over this region. As evening falls, dine on local delicacies under a canopy of stars as the volcano looms in the background as a silent sentinel.

DAY 2 »

Arenal Volcano

Wake to the chorus of tropical birds. You have two exhilarating options to explore the forest canopy this morning. For the most immersive experience, join your naturalist guide on a walk along hanging bridges. These suspended walkways offer an intimate look at life in the canopy. Feel the bridges sway gently as you move, and pause to observe orchids clinging to branches, bromeliads forming miniature ecosystems, and even sloths slowly making their way through the foliage. For the adrenaline seekers, strap into a zipline and soar through the treetops, feeling the rush of wind and catching glimpses of the colorful birds and curious monkeys.

In the afternoon, your feet are back on terra firma as you explore the lower slopes of Arenal Volcano. This hike takes you across otherworldly lava fields, where you'll feel the crunch of cooled lava beneath your boots. The contrasts are striking - barren lava flows give way to lush vegetation, showcasing nature's resilience. Your guide will help you spot pioneer species taking root in the volcanic soil, telling a story of rebirth and renewal.

DAY3 »

Arenal / Osa Peninsula

Start your day with a heartwarming visit to a local village school. A short, easy walk through the community offers glimpses into daily tico life. At the school, you'll be greeted by the excited chatter of children and their teachers. They'll welcome you to join in a traditional game or to help with an English lesson. This immersive experience is at the heart of regenerative travel at Classic Journeys as we help sustain the cultures and ways of life of the people we visit on tour.

As you fly from La Fortuna to Puerto Jimenez, you'll witness a dramatic change in landscape. The conical shape of Arenal Volcano gives way to lush, unbroken expanses of rainforest. The Osa Peninsula appears as a verdant jewel set against the blue Pacific Ocean. National Geographic called it ""the most biologically intense place on Earth", and you'll start to see that firsthand on a walk this afternoon. The terrain is relatively flat with some gentle inclines, featuring well-maintained trails through lowland tropical rainforest. You'll immediately notice the increase in humidity and the rich, earthy scent of leaves on the forest floor. Listen for the raucous calls of Fiery-billed Aracari Toucans and the howls of howler monkeys. You might spot sloths in the trees or catch glimpses of white-faced capuchin monkeys swinging through the canopy.

DAY4 »

Osa Peninsula / Golfo Dulce

A short walk through the rainforest leads to the dock where our boat captain joins your naturalist guide to lead you on an exciting wildlife-watching excursion in the Golfo Dulce. This pristine gulf is known as the only place in the world where the northern and southern humpback whales come seasonally to deliver their babies (with peak season July to December), as well as for its year-round residents that include three different species of dolphins, sea turtles, iguanas, and a variety of marine birds. The viewing is amazing from the boat, and even more immersive if you opt to use the snorkeling gear we provide you to join the marine life underwater.

Returning to land, a short drive leads to a family-run agroecological farm, owned by friends of ours. This immersive experience offers a perfect blend of nature, culture, and culinary exploration. Join your hosts on a stroll through lush organic orchards filled with tropical fruits, and to discover the rich history of medicinal plants on the Osa Peninsula. Then get a firsthand look (and tasting) at the fascinating process of chocolate-making from bean to bar. Back at your boutique resort, you have time to swim, relax, or explore more on your own in the late afternoon.

DAY 5 »

Osa Peninsula / Río Nuevo Nature Reserve

Today, embark on an exhilarating morning adventure on a guided nature walk into the Osa Peninsula's lush wilderness. The Río Nuevo Nature Reserve offers a kaleidoscope of colors, smells, sights, and sounds. You'll spot vibrant Scarlet Macaws that are iconic to the region, Red-throated Caracaras, and Orange-collared Manakins. Your footpaths wind through a pristine primary rainforest, where you'll find yourself surrounded by ancient trees and diverse plant species that have thrived without any human interference. This untouched ecosystem boasts remarkably old trees, where natural ecological processes have flourished for centuries, creating a vibrant and well-preserved environment teeming with life. The animal viewing is fantastic too, including all four Costa Rican primate species - squirrel monkeys, spider monkeys, white-faced capuchins, and howler monkeys. Your walk culminates with a refreshing dip in the crystal-clear waters of the river, providing a perfect respite after your exploration.

This afternoon offers a unique choice: act like a sloth or join your guide in search of sloths! If you choose to act like one, relax poolside at your boutique resort; maybe even opting for a spa treatment or yoga class. If you prefer to go in search of sloths, join your guide on a walk to get face-to-face with Costa Rica's most beloved and elusive mammal. In a lush 30-acre sanctuary owned by a local family who are our friends, you'll find pristine forests that support sloths in their natural habitat. As you meander along well-maintained trails, your expert guide will share fascinating insights about these slow-moving, fuzzy creatures and their crucial role in the ecosystem. Keep your eyes peeled for both two-toed and three-toed sloths as they languidly navigate the treetops or curl up for a nap.

DAY 6 »

Osa Peninsula / San Jose

On your final morning, sleep in or enjoy one of two memorable experiences, depending on the conditions. If the sand temperatures are optimal for turtle hatchings, you can opt to participate in a heartwarming and conservation-focused activity—helping with the release of baby sea turtle hatchlings. With guidance from our naturalists, learn about the efforts to protect these endangered creatures and play a part in their journey to the sea.

Even if the baby turtles are not hatching, morning is a time of rebirth for the vibrant bird species that inhabit the area. Join your guide for a walk in search of stunning birds such as Scarlet Macaws, known for their brilliant plumage, the elusive Resplendent Quetzal, and the striking White-throated Magpie-Jay. The soft morning light enhances visibility, allowing you to really appreciate the vivid colors of the birds, and it's a perfect time to observe them feeding and singing.

Later, transfer to the Puerto Jimenez airport for your flight back to San José, where your Costa Rican adventure comes to an end, leaving you with unforgettable memories of this tropical paradise.
