Echoes of France, Close to Home

We have a friend who says that when she's in the mood for France she just heads for Québec. Interesting advice—but it doesn't do justice to the unique New World culture and landscape of this province. True, the first Frenchmen sailed up in 1535, and their influence is still obvious—in the food, language and architecture. As the only fortified city in North America, Québec City might look just as at home on the Dordogne River as the St. Lawrence. The farmland may even remind you of Normandy. The most startling discovery, though, is that the European past thrives so near to home. The Charlevoix region was declared a Heritage Cultural Region by UNESCO. On a fascinating series of walks, we'll learn why as we visit the villages, the tradespeople and the terrain which make this one of our favorite destinations anywhere. Join us and see how it feels to go to Europe without leaving the continent.

DAY 1 »

Québec City

- Stroll through cobbled streets and leafy lanes as your guide reveals Québec City's living history.
- Capture panoramic views of the St. Lawrence River from the iconic Chateau Frontenac's grand terrace.

Your adventure begins in historic Québec City, perched above the St. Lawrence River. As you set out on a warm-up walk, you'll feel time slip away beneath your feet-winding upward from the cobbled lanes of the Lower Town, passing under century-old trees, and soaking in the city's irresistible blend of French and British heritage. Your well-connected local guide brings the city's stories to life, leading you through charming Rue du Petit-Champlain, past inviting cafés and boutiques, and on to the grand Chateau Frontenac for panoramic river views. This is a city that wears its history with pride, and you're discovering it at eye level, just like a local friend would show you.

This evening, settle into the rhythm of Québec with a welcome dinner that's as much about the company as the cuisine. You'll sip your aperitif under a 17th-century vaulted ceiling before moving on to savor a leisurely meal at one of the city's finest spots. There's time to linger over dessert, coffee, or a nightcap-your first taste of the warmth and whimsy that defines this region and your Classic Journeys experience.

DAY 2 »

Hautes-Gorges / La Malbaie

- Wander along a river path in Les Hautes-Gorges, surrounded by dramatic cliffs and soaring peaks.
- Settle into a boutique hotel perched above the St. Lawrence, enjoying its serene and scenic setting.

After breakfast, you'll leave the city's bustle behind for the cinematic countryside of Charlevoix. Church steeples dot the landscape as you journey to the National Park Les Hautes-Gorges-de-la-Rivière-Malbaie-one of Québec's natural masterpieces. Your curated walk follows a gravel path along the river, hemmed in by sheer stone walls and the highest peaks east of the Rockies. Peregrine falcons may soar overhead, and if you're lucky, you might spot a rare caribou. With your expert guide at your side, you'll experience the valley's grandeur and learn the stories that shape this wild corner of the world.

By afternoon, you arrive in La Malbaie, a resort town that has charmed politicians and artists for generations. Your home for the next two nights is a perfectly sited boutique hotel perched dramatically above the St. Lawrence. Here, you'll dine and unwind like a local, with the river and mountains as your backdrop.

DAY 3 »

Tadoussac

- Embark on a thrilling whale-watching adventure, spotting minke, fin, and possibly beluga whales.
- Walk scenic footpaths to Tadoussac, Canada's first fur trading post, rich with history.

Today's journey takes you along the St. Lawrence and into the heart of the majestic Saguenay Fjord-a place where freshwater and saltwater mingle to create one of the world's richest marine ecosystems. All aboard for a thrilling whale-watching excursion: keep your eyes peeled for minke, fin, and perhaps even the elusive beluga whale. Your small group and naturalist guide ensure you're right in the heart of the action, learning about the region's unique wildlife and the delicate balance of this extraordinary environment.

After lunch in a cozy Tadoussac café, you'll set out on foot along scenic paths overlooking the fjord and river. Your walk leads you to Tadoussac, Canada's first fur trading post, where Samuel de Champlain landed in 1603. With every step, you're immersed in the stories and landscapes that make this region unforgettable-a true "only with Classic Journeys" day.

DAY 4 »

St-Joseph-de-la-Rive / Baie-St-Paul

- Discover the art of papermaking and experience a hands-on lavender workshop with a local expert.
- Explore Baie-St-Paul's crater valley, then stroll scenic paths with a naturalist along the St. Lawrence.

This morning, you head south to St-Joseph-de-la-Rive, where you'll drop in on a charming paper museum and witness deluxe papers being handcrafted using 17th-century techniques. Later in the morning, you visit a historic lavender farm, where your friend Louise, who is both the owner and a certified lavender biologist, welcomes you personally and guides you around the property. She shares the farm's rich heritage dating back to 1844 and the surrounding landscape. You'll enjoy a hands-on activity with the lavender plants, tour the drying shed and the still where lavender hydrosol is produced, and finish with a tasting of lemon lavender cake and a glass of freshly squeezed sparkling lavender lemonade. The farm, awarded the Charlevoix Heritage Award, offers a truly authentic encounter with local tradition.

What seems to be just a remarkably broad valley with rolling hills and seaside villages is, in fact, an enormous crater formed by a meteorite impact some 350 million years ago! At its heart is Baie-St-Paul, a lively center for the arts and birthplace of Cirque du Soleil. Meeting up with a naturalist friend, you'll explore the local flora and fauna as you follow a path past scenic fields and along a sandy beach on the shore of the St. Lawrence River.

Later in the afternoon, you're free to explore the art galleries and museums in the village-Baie-Saint-Paul is renowned for its vibrant arts scene, with nearly twenty galleries and the acclaimed Musée d'art contemporain de Baie-Saint-Paul all within walking distance. Dinner is on your own this evening, whether in town or at your boutique hotel.

DAY 5 »

Grands-Jardins National Park

- Ascend Mont du Lac des Cygnes, traversing aspen groves and glacier-carved lakes with sweeping views.
- Marvel at the vast Charlevoix crater from the summit, surrounded by pristine wilderness and fresh air.

This morning, you're off to Grands-Jardins National Park, where the immensity of the Charlevoix crater unfolds before you. Your walk-curated for both beauty and purpose-ascends Mont du Lac des Cygnes, weaving through groves of trembling aspen, past glacier-carved lakes, and into forests of black spruce and balsam fir. At the summit, you'll stand on the rim of the ancient crater, with Lac des Cygnes glittering below and limitless views stretching in every direction. Your guide, a true friend of the region, shares local lore and natural history as you picnic in the fresh mountain air.

After a day spent in the wilds of Québec, you'll gather for a farewell dinner at your guide's favorite local restaurant. It's a perfect, convivial end to your Charlevoix adventure-one last chance to toast new friends and savor the flavors of the region.

DAY 6 »

Île d'Orléans / Québec City

- Wander among heritage homes and gardens on Île d'Orléans, meeting locals preserving island traditions.
- Walk to the top of Montmorency Falls for breathtaking views of Québec City's skyline and river.

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before crossing to Île d'Orléans, an island that feels like a living museum of French-Canadian heritage. Your scenic walk leads you to Sainte-Pétronille, the island's most picturesque village, where Regency-style English villas and lovingly tended gardens line the way. Your guide introduces you to the island's stories and its people-keepers of traditions that date back centuries.

Before returning to Québec City, you'll visit Montmorency Falls, which tumble dramatically from a height one-and-a-half times that of Niagara. A lovely walk brings you to a bridge above the cascade, offering a breathtaking (and safe) vantage point for photos with the city and Chateau Frontenac rising in the distance. Back in Québec City, you'll bid farewell to your guide and the friends you've made, carrying home memories of a journey that could only happen with Classic Journeys.

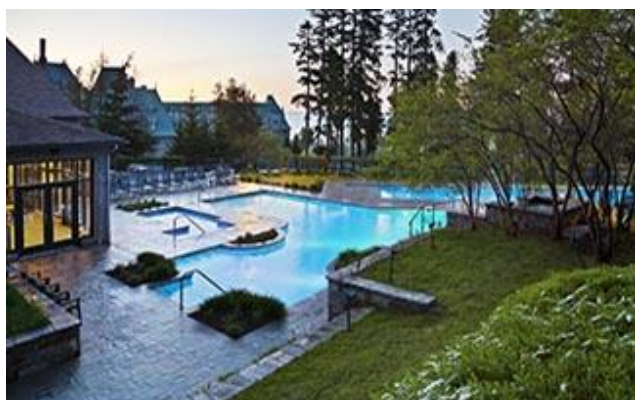
